


Cross Squares Blue



Finished block 10" x 10"

Fabric needed $\frac{1}{4}$ Yard of each
Lt. Blue, Dk. Blue, White

Cutting for ONE Quilt Block



Cut 4 Lt. Blue – $2 \frac{7}{8}$ " x $2 \frac{7}{8}$ "

Cut 4 White – $2 \frac{7}{8}$ " x $2 \frac{7}{8}$ "




Make Triangles

Cut 16 White – $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $1 \frac{1}{2}$ "

Cut 16 Dk. Blue – $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $1 \frac{1}{2}$ "







Make 4-Patches


Cut 4 White – 4 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Cut 1 Dk. Blue 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Sew as shown



Quilt Idea for You !



GETTING STARTED

Squares


Cut 2 – 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares the same size (finished size of square plus 1/2 inch)

Good to good Fabric

1/4 inch seam allowance, sew

Trim threads

Open and Press to the dark



Triangles

Cut 2- 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" Squares

(finished size plus 7/8")

Good to good fabric, with a pencil draw a line corner to corner, this is

The line you measure your 1/4" seam allowance from

Sew from edge to edge use a 1/4" seam

Cut in half on the pencil line, trim threads

Open and press to the dark fabric,

There will be 2 blocks
